

TK-12 Student Dress code

2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR



SHIRTS

- Students must wear a polo shirt (long or short sleeve) in approved Academy Colors: **royal blue, navy blue, green, orange, black, grey, white**
- A TPAA logo-branded team, activity, or club shirt is acceptable (e.g., Robotics, Science Olympiad, Link Crew, and Web Crew).

PANTS, SHORTS, AND SKIRTS

Academy-approved colors (**royal blue, navy blue, black, grey, Khaki/tan**)

Pants: (royal blue, navy blue, black, grey, khaki/tan)

- Must be fitted at the waist (no sagging or low-riding)
- Jeans must be dark-wash only (if worn)
- Must be worn right-side out with finished hems
- No rips, tears, holes, cutoff styles, or frayed edges
- No non-factory cuffs or alterations
- Pants must not drag on the ground
- Belts must be worn properly (no hanging ends; no spiked or studded belts)

Shorts: (royal blue, navy blue, black, grey, khaki/tan)

- Denim shorts must be dark-wash only (if worn)
- Hemlines must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Shorts extending below the knee may not be worn with over-the-calf socks

Skirts, Dresses: (royal blue, navy blue, black, grey, khaki/tan)

- Denim skirts must be dark-wash only (if worn)
- Hemlines and slits must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- No strapless, backless, or transparent styles are permitted

SWEATERS AND HOODIES

- Academy-approved colors (**royal blue, navy blue, green, orange, black, grey, white**)
- ***Polos must still be worn underneath**

SHOES

- Students must wear appropriate **closed-toe footwear at all times.**
- Shoelaces are restricted to **solid, black, white, or brown.**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Can my student wear any color polo?** No. To follow our school Dress Code Policy, students should wear polo shirts in one of the approved colors: **royal blue, navy blue, green, orange, black, gray, or white.**
- 2. Are jeans allowed under the updated Student Dress Code?** Under the updated Student Dress Code, dark denim / dark wash jeans are permitted as long as they meet the guidelines outlined in the dress code policy. Please refer to the Student Dress Code Policy included in this communication for more detailed information.
- 3. Can my Student wear leggings, yoga pants, or athletic pants during the school day?** No. Leggings/jeggings, yoga, and athletic pants are not permitted during the regular school day under the Student Dress Code. Athletic pants may only be worn during a scheduled Physical Education (PE) class or while participating in a school-sponsored athletic event or activity. Students are expected to follow the Student Dress Code before and after PE or athletic participation.
- 4. What is the plan to ensure the successful and consistent implementation of the updated Student Dress Code?** The Board-approved Student Dress Code will be implemented Academy-wide to help maintain a consistent, safe, and professional learning environment for all students. Families will receive a copy of the Dress Code, which will also be shared through ParentSquare, posted on the school website, reviewed during student orientations and assemblies, and discussed at parent meetings such as Coffee with the Principal. Student Dress Code expectations will be monitored daily, and staff will communicate with families regarding any violations. The Academy will follow a progressive discipline process for Dress Code violations, beginning with parent notification and corrective support, and moving to additional interventions if violations continue. We value parents and guardians as partners in their child's education and appreciate your support in helping your student follow the Dress Code. Together, we can maintain a positive, respectful, and focused learning environment for all students. Thank you for helping us keep our schools safe, welcoming, and where students are ready to learn. **Please refer to the attached Student Dress Code Policy for more detailed information.**
- 5. Can I opt my child out of the school's dress code?**
No. The school's dress code is not a school uniform policy. Under California law, the parent opt-out provision only applies to schoolwide uniform policies adopted pursuant to California Education Code section 35183. Because our policy establishes standards for appropriate student attire, there is no statutory opt-out provision. Students are expected to comply with the school's dress code while attending school and school-sponsored activities.
